



Where to Celebrate AAPI Heritage Month in Cincinnati

CINCINNATI, Ohio — In a campaign led by Asianati, more than 15 events celebrating Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) Heritage Month in Greater Cincinnati will be hosted by AAPI organizations, art and culture institutions, and businesses during May. From free events to ticketed celebrations — events include arts and cultural festivals, history lectures, art exhibitions, food tastings, and sports games.

“AAPI Heritage Month unites us by providing opportunities to learn about, connect with, and celebrate the Asian American community, which makes Cincinnati better,” Billy Guinigundo, chairperson of AAPI Heritage Month Cincinnati, said. “AAPI Heritage Month shines a spotlight on the history and contributions of AAPI people — who have been crucial to the community story despite going unnoticed or underappreciated in the past.”

New to AAPI Heritage Month Cincinnati in 2024 is a five-day long Asian film series at Esquire and Kenwood Theatres, an Asianati craft market at Humble Monk Brewing Co., AAPI Heritage Night at a FC Cincinnati match, Asianati Night at a Cincinnati Reds game, and an Asian food tasting tour at Findlay Market.
